Songs

Advantage - you can do songs anywhere - with little or no equipment/materials! Disadvantage-some people can't sing or are embarrassed about it. Use a tape or a CD! Remember to bring an extension cord if you'll be working with girls in a large room.

Disadvantage of songs on paper or posterboard---some girls can't read yet.

One easy way to teach is to sing a whole verse of a song and the chorus, then go back and sing a line and have girls echo it back to you. If you have some background on a song-where it originated, etc, share it.

Begin by letting the little girls test their voices by singing easy songs they know-maybe Mary Had A Little Lamb or Twinkle Star. Next, have poster board or a projector showing the words to the songs. This makes it a bit easier for those who CAN read to learn the songs. You can also have handouts of the songs for each girl. Spirit/camaraderie built better without papers, though. On some of the songs, try adding easy hand motions or a dance for them to do.

Materials needed: Poster board or butcher paper. markers, or overhead projector (if you don't use the poster board idea) song sheets-materials you choose depend or where/how you will be teaching the songs.

CAUTION: There are some rotten versions and verses to songs Out There. Please be especially vigilant when you ask girls to share songs they know. Whenever possible, ask them to sing the song quietly to you so you can decide whether it's appropriate.

Even some of the songs below have a few risqué lyrics! Delete any that you feel uncomfortable with or that you feel are not appropriate for your girls. Be sure to delete them <u>ahead of time</u>, as you may be happily singing along and sing them by mistake!

There is a 90^{th} anniversary Girl Scout songs tape/CD available at the Council office. Some of the songs are really good. It costs about \$10.
