Pass out the words to "Brother Hold My Hand", explain its history, and then go to: http://www.zbt.org/documents/brothers_hand.wma. Play the song, ask the group to sing along twice, and then ask them to sing it without music, twice.

If the chapter has any local songs or chants teach them those at this session.

Suggested Activity:

After this session take new and old brothers out to serenade some sororities after a chapter meeting. Do it on a Monday night. Knock on their door sing our song and welcome their new sisters and introduce our new brothers. It's a great way to practice song.
